About this guide

The Thunder Bay Chamber of Commerce in collaboration with Huron Chamber of Commerce prepared this guide as a consolidated reference for Thunder Bay businesses navigating the changing Canada-U.S. trade environment. It replaces separate Chamber guides to U.S. Section 338 tariffs and Canada's September 8 counter-tariffs, and adds the other tariff measures, relief programs and business supports needed to understand the broader trade picture.

Current as of September 15, 2026

This guide uses the Section 338 product scope effective September 15, 2026. Separate U.S. import prohibitions on specified Canadian alcoholic beverages, dairy-related products and motorcycles are announced for September 29. Appendix B contains the current September 15 Section 338 list and identifies the products scheduled for prohibition on September 29.

Use this as a navigation tool, not a customs ruling

Tariff treatment depends on product classification, origin, entry date, composition and the specific legal authority being applied. Product descriptions in this guide are shortened for readability. Confirm a specific shipment with a qualified customs broker, trade adviser, CBSA or U.S. Customs and Border Protection before making business decisions.

Principal sources

1. Trade landscape at a glance and timeline

There is no single “Canada-U.S. tariff.” Several measures now operate at the same time, and the applicable treatment can differ substantially depending on the product and its origin. The following table is a starting point only.

How the current tariff landscape developed

The current tariff picture is the result of several measures introduced and revised over a short period. This timeline focuses on the major 2026 changes covered by this guide.

Date	Measure	What changed
Apr. 6, 2026	U.S. Section 232	A major 2026 steel, aluminum and copper framework took effect. Many primary metal products became subject to 50% duties, specified derivatives to 25%, and selected fixed industrial machinery and power equipment to temporary 15% treatment. For many covered products, the duty applies to the full customs value.
Jun. 8, 2026	U.S. Section 232	Further changes took effect, including revised treatment for agricultural equipment, industrial machinery and residential HVAC products. Special treatment was also introduced for certain Canadian and Mexican CUSMA-qualified goods based on non-U.S. content, subject to a minimum 15% effective duty.
Jul. 20, 2026	U.S. Section 338	Three proclamations announced additional 50% duties on specified Canadian goods in response to U.S. complaints concerning alcoholic beverages, dairy and motor vehicles. The original effective date was August 19.
Jul. 24, 2026	U.S. Section 301	A 10% Section 301 tariff took effect on most Canadian goods following U.S. forced-labour investigations, replacing the expired Section 122 surcharge. CUSMA goods qualifying for preferential duty-free treatment remain exempt, and other product exclusions also apply.
Aug. 18, 2026	U.S. Section 338	The United States delayed the effective date of the three Section 338 tariff proclamations by three days, from August 19 to August 22.
Aug. 22, 2026	U.S. Section 338	The 50% Section 338 duties took effect on the listed Canadian products. Unlike Section 301, there is no general CUSMA exemption for covered Section 338 goods.
Aug. 25, 2026	Canadian counter-tariffs	Canada announced a new package of 15%, 25% and 50% counter-tariffs on U.S.-origin goods covering \$27.6 billion in imports, effective September 8. Earlier Canadian countermeasures, including automobiles, remained in place.
Aug. 26, 2026	Canadian counter-tariffs	Finance Canada revised the planned September 8 product list before implementation. The current schedule contains 629 tariff items. Fish and seafood lines were removed from the planned list and nine tariff items were added.
Sep. 8, 2026	Canada and U.S. Section 338	Canada’s new counter-tariff package took effect. The same day, the United States announced Section 338 scope modifications for September 15 and separate import prohibitions for September 29.
Sep. 15, 2026	U.S. Section 338	The current revised Section 338 product scope took effect. Salt and Portland cement are among the products no longer on the tariff list, while other HTS provisions were added, narrowed or refined. Appendix B shows only the products covered under the current schedule.
Sep. 29, 2026 (announced)	U.S. Section 338	Specified Canadian alcoholic beverages, certain dairy-related products and motorcycles over 800 cc are scheduled to move from the 50% Section 338 tariff to an import prohibition, subject to the timing rules in the proclamations.

Timeline note: This is a practical summary of major effective and announced changes. It is not a substitute for transaction-specific customs verification, and trade measures may change quickly.

Do not add the rates together automatically

Different measures have different rules. However, the September 8 U.S. proclamations state that Section 338 duties, as modified, apply in addition to Section 232 duties where both regimes cover the same product. That makes classification and the applicable effective date especially important under the current September 15 Section 338 scope.

2. U.S. Section 232 sectoral tariffs

Section 232 of the U.S. Trade Expansion Act is the authority used for sector-specific national-security tariffs. For Canadian exporters, it is now a collection of separate regimes rather than a single tariff. CUSMA treatment is category-specific and should never be assumed to eliminate Section 232 exposure.

The most locally relevant Section 232 issue for many manufacturers is the metals regime. The Chamber's June bulletin noted that agricultural equipment, material-handling equipment, HVAC components, steel racks, fabricated products and machinery assemblies can be affected even when the finished good would not normally be described as "steel," "aluminum" or "copper."

3. U.S. Section 301 tariffs

On July 24, 2026, the United States imposed a 10% tariff under Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974 on imports of most goods from Canada and a number of other countries following investigations concerning enforcement of prohibitions on imports produced using forced labour. This replaced the temporary Section 122 tariff structure that expired the same day.

CUSMA matters here

Goods that qualify for preferential duty-free treatment under CUSMA are exempt from the Section 301 tariff. A range of products is also fully excluded from the Section 301 measure. Businesses should confirm CUSMA qualification rather than assuming that Canadian origin alone is enough.

Because Section 301 is a broad measure with CUSMA and product exclusions rather than a targeted Canada-only tariff list like Section 338, this guide does not reproduce a separate product appendix for Section 301.

4. U.S. Section 338 tariffs and September 29 prohibitions

The United States imposed additional 50% Section 338 duties on a broad range of Canadian products on August 22, 2026, following three July proclamations addressing U.S. complaints involving alcoholic beverages, dairy and motor vehicles. Section 338 does not provide an exemption for CUSMA-compliant goods.

Current Section 338 scope, effective September 15

The current Section 338 product scope applies to goods entered for consumption, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, at or after 12:01 a.m. Eastern Time on September 15, 2026. The September 8 scope-modification proclamations revised the covered HTS provisions. Appendix B reproduces only the products covered under the current September 15 schedule.

Stacking with Section 232

The September 8 modification proclamations state that the Section 338 duties, as modified, apply in addition to Section 232 duties. A covered product can therefore require analysis under both authorities.

September 29 import prohibitions

Separate September 8 proclamations exclude specified Canadian goods from importation into the United States beginning at 12:01 a.m. Eastern Time on September 29. The bans cover specified alcoholic beverages, specified whey, molasses and non-alcoholic beer products, and motorcycles with engine displacement over 800 cc. For products imported before September 29 but not yet entered for consumption or withdrawn from warehouse, the proclamations provide that the 50% Section 338 duty continues to apply.

5. Canadian counter-tariffs

Canada's countermeasures apply to U.S.-origin imports entering Canada. The September 8, 2026 package responds to the U.S. Section 338 measures and applies 15%, 25% or 50% surtaxes to products covering \$27.6 billion in imports from the United States. The current September 8 schedule contains 629 tariff items.

Origin matters

The September 8 surtaxes apply to goods originating in the United States under the applicable country-of-origin marking rules. Buying from a U.S. supplier does not, by itself, establish U.S. origin. U.S. goods already in transit to Canada when the measures took effect are excluded from the September 8 surtax.

The September 8 package is not the whole Canadian response. Earlier counter-tariffs continue to apply, including the Canadian auto countermeasure. In sectors such as steel and aluminum, some previously existing 25% counter-tariffs increased to 50% under the September 8 package. Finance Canada now maintains a consolidated page as the authoritative source for tariff items, effective dates and rates.

Use Appendix C for the current September 8 schedule

Appendix C reproduces the 629 current tariff items in the September 8 counter-tariff package. For all Canadian countermeasures, including older measures, verify current treatment against Finance Canada's complete consolidated list and applicable CBSA notices.

6. CUSMA and tariff treatment

CUSMA remains central to Canada-U.S. trade, but it does not produce the same result under every tariff authority. Businesses should treat CUSMA qualification as one part of the tariff analysis, not as a universal exemption.

7. Tariff relief and duty recovery

Tariff exposure should be reviewed together with available relief mechanisms. Relief is transaction-specific, and eligibility, documentation and timing requirements matter.

Mechanism	What it does	When to look at it
Tariff remission	The federal government can remit tariffs in exceptional circumstances. Businesses not covered by prior temporary remission orders may submit an individual remission request to Finance Canada.	When tariffs create exceptional hardship, inputs are unavailable domestically, or another strong policy case exists.
Duties Relief Program	Allows eligible importers to defer duties on imported goods that will later be exported, either in the same condition or after processing.	When imported inputs are used in goods that will be exported.
Duty Drawback Program	Allows eligible businesses to recover certain duties already paid on imported goods that are subsequently exported.	When duties have already been paid and qualifying goods or products are exported.
Customs classification / origin review	A classification or origin error can create tariff exposure that should not exist.	Before pursuing relief, confirm the tariff item, origin, valuation and entry treatment.

8. Financing and business support

Federal and Ontario support has expanded as the trade dispute has escalated. The programs below are the most relevant broad-based supports for Thunder Bay businesses as of September 15, 2026. Program rules can change, so confirm eligibility before relying on any amount or term.

9. Trade, workforce and diversification resources

Financial support is only one part of the response. Businesses should also use customs, export-market, workforce and data resources to reduce risk and find alternatives.

Workforce measures can also be relevant when tariff impacts affect hours or staffing. Employers should review EI Work-Sharing and other federal or provincial worker-support measures where reduced activity is expected, and confirm current program conditions through official government sources.

10. Thunder Bay business context and practical checklist

Local exposure extends beyond direct exporters

The Thunder Bay Chamber's August tariff-impact survey found that 47% of respondents exported directly to the United States, but 65% purchased goods, materials or components from the United States and 65% believed their customers could be affected. Fifty-nine per cent identified pricing changes as a potential effect, 53% anticipated reduced sales or orders, 47% identified higher costs and 41% identified supply-chain disruption. Just over half, 53%, described the potential business impact as moderate or significant.

Those results reinforce why a local tariff review should consider inputs, suppliers, customers and investment decisions, not only goods physically crossing the border under the company's own name.

Practical tariff review checklist

- Identify the HS/HTS classification for every product, material and component that may cross the border.
- Confirm country of origin under the rule that applies to the specific tariff measure. Do not equate supplier location with origin.
- Check CUSMA qualification and maintain the records needed to support the claim.
- Review Section 232, Section 301 and Section 338 separately for U.S.-bound goods. Confirm whether Section 338 and Section 232 both apply under the current September 15 scope.
- For Canadian imports, check Finance Canada's consolidated counter-tariff list and CBSA notices.
- For goods affected by the September 29 Section 338 prohibitions, review shipment and entry timing immediately with the U.S. importer and customs broker.
- Review contracts and Incoterms to determine who bears tariff, customs, documentation and delay risk.
- Ask whether remission, duties relief, drawback or financing support can reduce the impact.
- Document assumptions and re-check them before major sourcing, pricing, contract or investment decisions because the measures can change quickly.

Appendix A. Section 232 detailed sector reference

Section 232 is a set of sector-specific regimes. Unlike Appendix B and Appendix C, there is no single compact Canada-only tariff schedule that can be reproduced accurately as one table. This appendix therefore summarizes each active or announced regime, the principal rates and the treatment most relevant to Canadian businesses. The controlling U.S. proclamations, annexes and HTSUS provisions remain authoritative.

Section 232 metals: Chamber June 2026 note

The Chamber's Section 232 member bulletin highlighted a June 8 adjustment affecting steel, aluminum and copper articles and derivatives. It advised manufacturers to review products by HTS code, document U.S.-produced parts and metal-origin content, and not assume CUSMA qualification removes the tariff. For certain listed Canadian/Mexican CUSMA-qualified goods, the bulletin noted a 25% duty calculation on non-U.S. content, subject to a 15% minimum effective duty, while the separate 85% U.S.-metal threshold may affect treatment under the wider framework.

Appendix B. Section 338 detailed HTS reference

Appendix B reproduces the Section 338 product schedule effective September 15, 2026, using the applicable U.S. HTS provisions and indicative descriptions as navigation aids. Products scheduled to become prohibited imports on September 29 remain in the current list through September 28 and are identified by their upcoming treatment. The White House proclamations, annexes and HTSUS control.

Current Section 338 reference

The tables below show the Section 338 schedule effective September 15. Where a row states “50% through Sep. 28; prohibited Sep. 29,” the 50% duty remains the current treatment through September 28, followed by the announced import prohibition, subject to the proclamation’s timing rules.

B1. September 29 import prohibitions

The following products move from the 50% tariff to an import prohibition on September 29, 2026. For alcohol rows marked “Packaged,” the White House annex limits the prohibition to products packaged in bottles, cans, boxes, kegs or similar direct-to-consumption containers.
